The Property

Four bedroom family home with opulent interiors on a historic street connecting South Kensington and Chelsea.

Entering the house on the ground floor, the front hall opens onto a generous reception room running the entire length of the building with two distinct seating areas. In addition, this floor contains a pair of double French doors leading out into the garden.





Indoor Spaces

Downstairs, the lower ground floor includes a spacious open-plan kitchen with a breakfast bar on the central island, a wine fridge and a separate dining area. On one side of the kitchen is a family television room and a guest loo. On the other side is a utility room, a plant room and separate street access.

The Bedrooms

The first floor contains a magnificent principal bedroom with high ceilings and tall windows, as well as an ensuite bathroom with a large free-standing bath. Meanwhile, the second floor contains a pair of bedrooms, sharing an ensuite bathroom. Finally, the third floor includes a fourth a bedroom with an ensuite bathroom. All these rooms are well-provided with storage space.

Outdoor Spaces & The Neighbourhood

The rear garden is unusually long for the street, with a paved seating areas and planted flowerbeds. In addition, there is a paved and gated front garden, giving added separation from the street. The first floor also contains a front balcony with enough space for outdoor seats.

Drayton Gardens is a beautiful street lined with a mix of terrace houses with white stucco dressings and red-brick mansion blocks. The street has been home to various well-known figures, while No.1 was once occupied by the artist, poet and writer Mervyn Peake, author of the Gormenghast novels. Drayton Gardens is close to the Old Brompton Road, with its mix of restaurants and independent shops. The Fulham Road is also close, while both Gloucester Road and South Kensington underground stations are within easy reach.
