The Property

Stepping into this charming family home through the raised ground floor entrance hall, you are welcomed by bright, light-filled interiors with elegant period details.

The entrance hall features decorative moulding and leads to the principal reception room, a generous space with high ceilings, large windows and an ornate fireplace. French doors connect seamlessly to the dining room, creating superb entertaining space with beautiful natural light throughout both rooms.

The kitchen is positioned at the rear of this floor, fitted with contemporary units, marble worktops and integrated appliances. French doors from the kitchen open directly onto the shared patio.



The Principal Bedroom

The first floor houses the impressive principal bedroom suite, a double-aspect room with an elegant fireplace and French doors leading to a private balcony. This floor is completed by a separate dressing room and a luxurious ensuite bathroom featuring both bath and shower facilities, with its own access to a second balcony.





Further Bedrooms

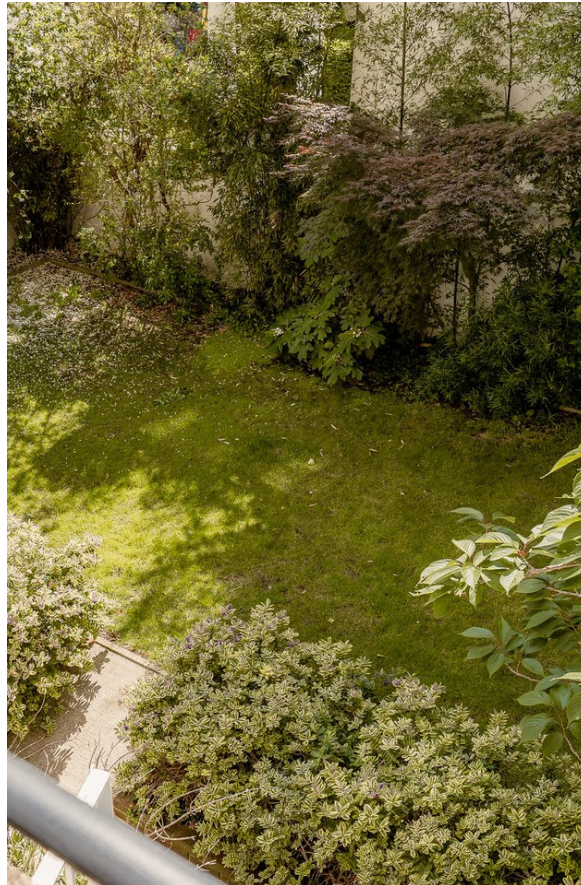
The lower ground floor accommodates two well-proportioned bedrooms, both with built-in storage solutions, served by two bathrooms, including one with French doors opening to a small courtyard area.

The second floor provides a fourth bedroom, maximising the accommodation across this well-planned family home.



Outdoor Spaces

The property includes access to a shared patio directly from the kitchen. Additionally, there is a private terrace accessed from the half landing, providing a quiet outdoor retreat. Most notably, the property includes access to the award-winning gardens of Onslow Square - some of the largest private gardens in the borough, beautifully laid out with lawns, flowerbeds and shaded woodland areas, providing a rare sanctuary in central London.





The Neighbourhood

Onslow Square is a prestigious garden square in South Kensington, renowned for its elegant white stucco terraced houses surrounding one of London's most distinguished private gardens. The square offers a peaceful residential setting while being moments away from the cultural attractions of South Kensington, including the Natural History Museum, Victoria and Albert Museum, and the Royal Albert Hall.

The area benefits from excellent transport links with South Kensington Underground station providing access to the District, Circle and Piccadilly lines. The fashionable shops and restaurants of King's Road and Knightsbridge are within easy reach, while Hyde Park offers extensive green space for recreation. The neighbourhood is also well-served by excellent schools and medical facilities, making it particularly suitable for families.

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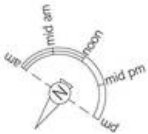
